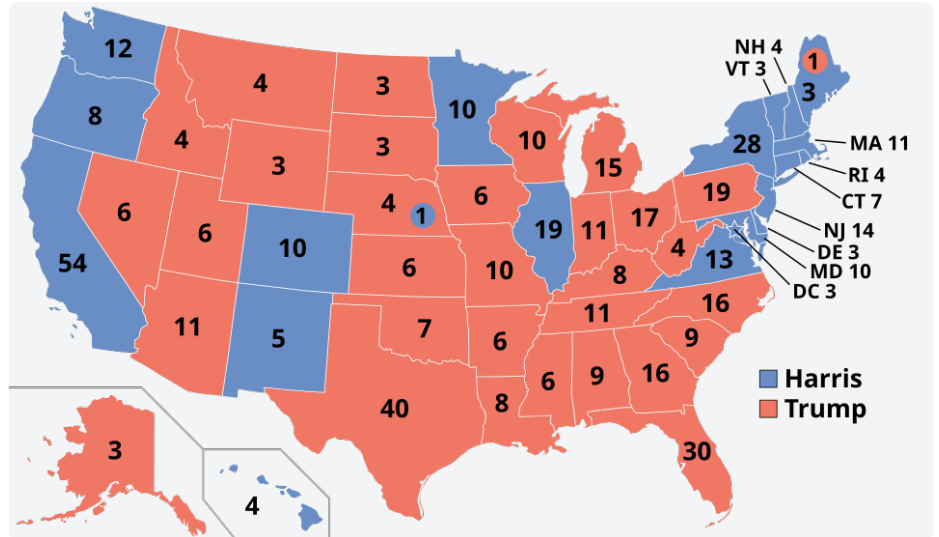

2024 Presidential Elections in the United States of America: The Countdown Begins

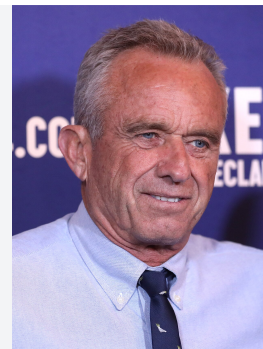
Donald Trump
