Wie verwende ich das simple present?

Verwendung

Das **simple present** drückt Fakten, aufeinanderfolgende und wiederholte Handlungen sowie festgelegte zukünftige Ereignisse aus. Wir verwenden das **simple present** für:

- Ereignisse, die regelmäßig oder gewohnheitsmäßig stattfinden (mit Signalwörtern)
- Ereignisse, die nacheinander stattfinden,
- Fakten oder Dinge, die allgemeingültig sind,
- zukünftige Handlungen, die geplant und vorbestimmt sind,
- statische Verben und Verben des Denkens/Gedächtnisses.

Signalwörter

Dies hier sind Signalwörter fürs **simple present**:

always, normally, usually, often, sometimes, seldom, never, every day/week/month etc.
